DIRECTIONS TO WHITE TANTRIC YOGA

From the East:

Take Rte. 95/128 to exit 16B (Rte. 109 Westwood).

Follow Rte. 109 to the west for 13 miles to Holliston St. in Medway.

Turn left onto Holliston Street and follow to the end.

Turn left onto Village St and take the first right onto Sanford Street (which later becomes Lincoln Street, then Main Street in Franklin).

In 5.6 miles you will pass in front of the Campus Center and come to Emmons Street on the right. Turn right onto Emmons and follow to the end.

Turn Right onto West Central Street and IMMEDIATELY turn right into Chapman Parking Lot. You will be behind the Campus Center. You can park in the first or second lot for Faculty and Staff.

Follow the walkway in the far back corner of the Staff/Faculty lot to the entrance of the Campus Center.

From the West:

Take Exit 17 (Rte. 140) toward Franklin. Rte 140 is also West Central Street.

Follow West Central Street about a mile toward Franklin.

After the traffic light at Union Street, turn left into Chapman Parking Lot. Park in either lot – the first or the Staff/Faculty lot.

You will be behind the Campus Center.

Follow the walkway in the far back corner of the Staff/Faculty lot to the entrance of the Campus Center.
